Summer Carriage Driving Clinics

South Hampton, NH – The Carriage Barn is pleased to announce that its Annual Kids Driving Clinics will be held at Black Magic Farm, in South Hampton, NH, weekly from June 27th through August 26th.

The 2011 Kids Driving Clinics Series will run July 11th – 15th and August 8th – 12th. Groups are forming now for kids ages “under 10” and “10 & over”, beginner through advanced levels.

Beginners are in for a special treat. The Carriage Barn’s Kids Driving Clinics for Beginners are amazing! Specially designed for who need to know “everything” there is to know about ponies, horses, and carts. No previous experience required. Carriage Barn Staff and Junior Counselors and will work on all aspects of driving. Students are introduced to harnessing, the history of carriages, and receive driving instruction each day in a fun and supportive team-oriented atmosphere.

For junior drivers who are ready to take ‘that next step’ in their driving experience, try our Intermediate Level clinic. This clinic includes daily hands-on driving, games, and roundtable discussions. The group will work as a team to enhance the experience & skills of all students. Carriage Barn staff and instructors will provide support, guidance & encouragement on both an individual and group level to enhance the drivers’ knowledge, confidence, and skill. This clinic provides ample opportunity for drivers to put their new found skills into practical application in a safe, supportive, & fun environment.

The Advanced Junior Level clinic is for advanced students that are ready for competition level. Drivers will hone their skills within the context of preparing for competition. Instruction, mock classes, in-depth discussions, and plenty of hands-on time are the order of the day. Drivers will design & run their own “show classes”.

Clinics run Monday through Friday, 9am to 3pm. Students must bring their own lunch, beverages, and snacks. Parent supervision is not required. Space is limited and early registration is encouraged. For those that cannot attend a driving clinic week, carriage driving lessons are available daily all Summer, as well as The Carriage Barn’s annual Horsemanship Clinics.
